Path to success: PREPARATION & QUICK RAPPORT!

- What is your goal for this photoshoot? eg. "My goal is to document the Jones family in such a way that they remember this great trip to my city and are reminded of the love they share with each other."
- 2. Prepare the route.
- 3. Prepare the shoot list.
- 4. Take into account the route, the ages, and your goal.
- Be deliberate in your lens choice you don't have time to switch. (Elena: "I
 typically use my 28-105L f4.0. I can get great compression as well as decent
 wide angles, and I never want a lower aperture than that anyway for
 backgrounds.")
- 6. Practice your poses, games, and invites.
- 7. Meet the clients in your real and authentic state. Establish your rapport & connection.
- 8. Stay present. Stay calm. Stay aware of their state.
- 9. Work your plan.
